- Territorial Headquarters: Jamaica
- 17 countries are included in the Caribbean territory: Antigua, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, French Guiana, Grenada, Guyana, Haiti, Jamaica, St. Kitts, St. Lucia, St. Maarten, St. Vincent, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago and the Turks and Caicos Islands.
- In 2014, Port of Spain Corps in the Trinidad Division celebrated 100 years of Service.
- The Caribbean is home to about 9% of the world’s coral reefs. Andros Island features the 140-mile long Andros Barrier Reef, one of the longest coral reefs in the world.
- The Caribbean Sea itself is one of the largest salt water seas on the planet, with an area of about 1,063,000 square miles.
