In addition to medical classes, students may also participate in sports, choir, special events, and other extracurricular activities. Morning devotions are held daily. The staff and students also contribute to World Services/Self-Denial and in 2019 raised over \$1,500 by holding food sales!

The education and training the students receive allows them to seek employment at government hospitals or other medical institutions. About 98% of fourth year students pass their university exams, demonstrating the excellence of the college!
