### **The Salvation Army Corps**

#### **Position:**

Mission Sergeant

#### **Ministry Description:**

The Mission Sergeant is responsible for the education of our congregation concerning The Salvation Army's work across the world with the ultimate goal of "partnering globally for the sake of the gospel."

The Sergeant responsibilities can include any of the following:

- Write a short update to be published in the monthly newsletter, if applicable.
- Make arrangements for a monthly Missions Moment during Sunday morning worship. This can include inviting guest speakers who have recently experienced a mission trip, using the monthly missions moment provided by the territorial World Missions Dept. or anything researched by the MS on the work of the global Salvation Army.
- The Mission Sergeant is also responsible to help encourage the congregation to participate in World Services fund raising.
- They will also be responsible for the Missions bulletin board if the corps has an available space.
- The Mission Sergeant is a member of the Corps Council.
